

com)The U.S. Supreme Court has agreed to hear the case of a Maryland woman who has been fighting for seven years to prove that she was owed more than \$4 million in back wages as a result of the Travelers Insurance Company underwriting policies, and improperly billing her business. Jermaine B. Brown, who now goes by Jermaine Brown, was an employee at a company called American International Marketing, Inc. from 2000 to 2004, where she worked in the International department. For three years, she got the feeling that something was wrong. "I had no idea that it was Travelers at the time. I thought it was American International," Brown said. When Brown spoke with one of the executives at American International, she claimed she was told the company was not "in the insurance business" and that Travelers would be billed for any claims. Brown said she only found out months later that her company had been underwritten by Travelers. "I just knew there was something going on and I had no idea where the money went. I knew there was a bill I was never sent," Brown said. "I was being taken advantage of." In 2004, she was advised that she was being laid off. The next day, she was told that her company had been taken over by another corporation called FLG and that she would be let go. Her company was "dumped," she said. Brown filed for unemployment benefits, and they denied her benefits, saying she was not an employee because she had not signed a contract. She was given a copy of the contract, which she said she had never signed. She was told that she was not an employee. She hired an attorney, who requested the financial records for American International. However, the company never sent the financial records. In 2006, Brown hired a third attorney, who called Travelers to inquire about the policies and billing process. Brown's third attorney said he called Travelers, but he couldn't get a straight answer as to who was responsible for the billing. "Travelers told me that they were not an underwriter, they did not issue the policy, they had no knowledge of the policy, and they did not bill American International," Brown said. The attorney said he called Travelers again in 2007, 82157476af
